In Years 5 and 6, we're learning the Year 4 content we missed due to the pandemic.

However, whenever possible, we're also trying to use some of the vocabulary and grammar expected in Years 5 and 6!

We sometimes use SUHUPU (Stand Up, Hand Up, Pair Up) to practise our Speaking and Listening Skills.

We've learnt about how nouns are either masculine or feminine – and how this affects the sentence.

After reading Le Grand Monstre Vert together, we discovered that, in French, the adjective usually comes after the noun!

We then used our knowledge of adjectives to help describe, and sometimes compare, zoo animals.
