

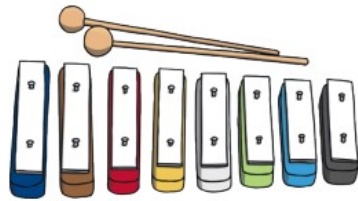

Things I can look out for when listening to old school Hip Hop:

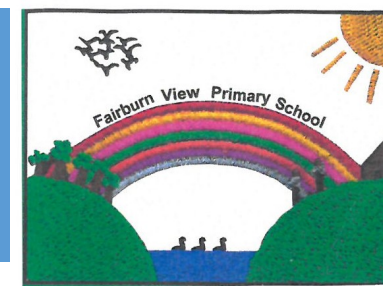
- Rapping and simple rhythms.

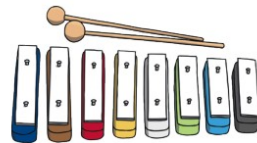

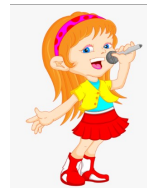

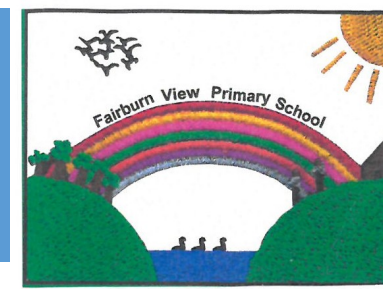
Rhythm in the way we walk and The Banana Rap

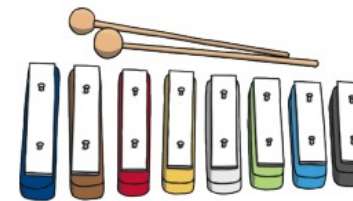

Styles of Music

- **Blues** - The song is sad and the words are about being in love. Electric guitar solos that are usually improvised
- **Baroque** - Uses trumpets and voice, Religious
- **Latin** - Dance music with a singer and backing vocals. Up-tempo and energetic
- **Bhangra** - The lyrics are in Punjabi, Hindi and Urdu. Drums, string instruments, keyboards and electronic sounds. Beat makes you want to dance
- **Irish Folk** - Instruments used in this tune include flute, penny whistle, drums and violin. There are no words or vocals and it is used for Irish dance
- **Funk** - Strong rhythmic groove, electric guitar riffs.
