<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Start to recognise when someone is older or younger than them.</li> <li>Recognise when something has changed at home or school</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Talk about some of the ways they have changed over their life</li> <li>Talk about some of their own and their family's history (grandparents, parents, etc.)</li> </ul>	<p>Know some similarities and differences between things in the past and now, drawing on their experiences and what has been read in class</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Give similarities and differences between the past and now</li> <li>Comment on images of familiar situations in the past.</li> <li>Compare and contrast characters from stories, including figures from the past.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Communication/schools/toys is/are different now (the present) and before now, in living memory (the past).</li> <li>My local community was different for families at different times in history.</li> </ul>
